Greetings all from Australia.

As the SEA games are being conducted later this year, we thought you may be considering giving your players some valuable international experience before November. Australia has some open entry events this year that may be of interest to you and your players.

In Melbourne in June we have the Reventon Classic Snooker championship. This event is played as a round robin (group stage), across several venues, on June 8th; followed by the elimination rounds on June 9th and 10th. There is a plate event on June 9th for those players who do not qualify for the elimination stage. This event is immediately followed by the Pacific International Billiards Championship – an event over 4 days, with a round-robin (group stage), and runs from June 11th to June 14th. The entry form for International players which covers both these events is attached.

In October in Melbourne we have the World Billiards Ltd. World Open and World Billiards Championships, from October 6th to 12th. Both events will be played with a round-robin format (group stage). We would be very pleased to host players from your country at any of these events. International players are always collected from and returned to the airport.
