NZBSA SELECTION POLICY (for IBSF World Championships)

- All selections / nominations for any International event to be subject to NZBSA Executive approval.
- All players wishing to represent New Zealand at IBSF Championships <u>must</u> be (a) a holder of a valid NZ passport or (b) if a holder of dual citizenship must not have represented another Country at Billiards or Snooker for a period of not less than 3 years.
- Any defending International Champion to be automatic No 1 selection / nomination for that particular event, subject to NZBSA Exec approval.
- IBSF Men Players to be nominated / selected in the following order. Defending International Champion (subject to IBSF qualifying criteria), Winner of NZ Championship, (should the winner of the NZ Championships decline the invitation to attend the IBSF World Championships this position will then be offered to the NZ Championship Runner-up), should the runner-up of the NZ Championships also decline then all positions will be filled from the separately maintained ranking list of the selected tournaments as named in Events Calendar, subject to NZBSA Exec approval.
- IBSF Ladies Players to be nominated / selected by the NZWBSA provided the nomination / selection criteria is in line with current NZBSA policies.
- IBSF Masters Players to be nominated / selected in the following order. Defending International Champion, Winner of NZ Seniors Championship, any further players to be selected from the Separate World Championship Ranking list.
- IBSF Under 21 Players to be nominated / selected in the following order. Defending International Champion (subject to qualifying criteria), Winner of NZ U21 Championship, any further selections / nominations to be based on NZBSA Ranking List, subject to NZBSA Exec approval.
- IBSF Under 21 Ladies Players to be nominated / selected by the NZWBSA provided the nomination / selection criteria is in line with current NZBSA policies.
