Change to the NZBSA Rules for Seeding at Ranking Events.

At the NZBSA Board meeting held on 23rd August 2008 the following alterations to the NZBSA Rules was approved.

Section 13 Seeding

Competitors in NZ Championships, NZ Open, Island Championships, Open Ranking Tournaments, and each Association's A Grade Championships, must be seeded into their sections in ranked order as determined by the latest New Zealand Ranking List. The Ranking List used to seed players for a Ranking Tournament will be the latest list received by the Host Association at the time the seedings are performed.

IN ANY OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED RANKING EVENTS THE CURRENT NZ CHAMPION (BILLIARDS & SNOOKER) WILL, IF ENTERED, BE THE NUMBER ONE SEED FOR THE TOURNAMENT. IF THE CURRENT NZ CHAMPION IS NOT ENTERED IN THE EVENT, THE NUMBER ONE SEED WILL BE HIGHEST RANKED PLAYER ON THE LATEST RANKING LIST THAT IS USED TO SEED THE FIELD FOR THE TOURNAMENT.
